Additional space for the Alaska State Museum collection, which has grown from 5,600 objects in 1967 to over 25,000 objects currently, is a critical issue to preserving the history and culture of the state and its peoples. The current building has exceeded capacity and much of the collection is being housed in temporary storage in the parking lot. Building expansion to accommodate and protect the current collection while making room for acquiring additional artifacts is paramount to preserving the state's history and culture. The building that is currently housing state archival documents has also exceeded capacity and is literally tearing apart. This project will provide funds for design of a facility that will
