Emergency funds from the Federal Highway Administration for declared emergencies. Within 180 days funded at 100% federal; after that, about 9% state match is needed. Special national discretionary funding for highways or airports may be accepted through this appropriation. May be used to address issues of emergency nature with federal airport or highway formula funds. Also used in cases where a revised program is not feasible.
