Brief Summary and Statement of Need:

The Ship Creek Access Route and Intermodal Marine Facility (IMF) project will address both land side and water access. Ingra Gamble extension and Whitney Road Improvements would upgrade the Port's connection to the NHS in Alaska; and, the IMF will upgrade the State's marine access to I-5 in the State of Washington. IMF elements of the project will upgrade an existing single purpose petroleum dock into an intermodal, multipurpose cargo and passenger facility. The proposed renovations will enable the Port to support passenger ships, bulk cargo ships, petroleum tankers, general cargo ships, and military sea lift vessels.
