Project Description/Justification:

The first phase of reconstruction of the Old Glenn Highway in Eagle River from a rural two-lane road to an urban three lane road, including a center turn lane, lighting, and separated pathway, has been accelerated to 2003 in the AMATS TIP. The municipality and the department have made commitments to the community for early construction of this project to accommodate substantially increased traffic projections created by recent development in the area including a Fred Meyer store. A supplemental appropriation will allow for project advertising and contract award early in the construction season. Under the normal capital budget process contract award would be delayed until July 1, which would adversely impact the ability to complete the project this summer.
