Project Description/Justification:

Authority is requested to receive funding from the Economic Development Administration (EDA) and other sources to expand the Yukon Flats Training Center. The addition will house the computer lab and provide space for utility-day or multi-week training programs in Voc-Tech and other disciplines. Existing programs now taught outside the region, including the Early Childhood Development Program and the Community Health Aide Program, will use the new facility. Future programs are being prepared for microcomputer support, small engine mechanics, tribal organization and management, natural resources management, small business development, and other training programs designed to fit community needs.

The facility will be used to expand and enhance educational and training opportunities for unemployed and underemployed adult residents of Fort Yukon and the surrounding communities of Arctic Village, Beaver, Birch Creek, Central, Calkyitsik, Circle, Rampart, Stevens Village and Venetie.
