Project Description/Justification:

This project is needed to repair deterioration of the small arms firing range backstop. The current backstop is collapsing, and in some portions large holes exist that present a safety concern during training conducted at this range. If repairs are not made, the range backstop will eventually fail completely and the range will be unusable. This will result in no on-site training and will require a minimum 1-hour travel time to and from an alternative range, reducing the amount of training time available.

Cost projections are based upon estimates from vendors for materials needed to complete this project and estimated labor costs.

No operating cost increases are anticipated to result from this project.
