Additional Information / Prior Funding History:

FY2004 - \$2,080,000; FY2003 - \$390,000; FY2001 - \$740,000. Increased cost estimate.

Project Description/Justification:

The Dalton Highway is the only surface transportation route from Interior Alaska to the oilfields and public lands of the North Slope. The attrition of the surface course on the highway is resulting in the accumulation of fines. Traffic disturbs these fines creating dust clouds that result in reduced visibility. This project is to provide a quality driving surface that will reduce summer maintenance costs and improve safety.
