**Brief Summary and Statement of Need:**

Project is a part of the Southeast Alaska Transportation plan. Construct a new Alaska Marine Highway System (AMHS) ferry terminal on the southern end of Mitkof Island. Preliminary engineering proposes a vessel berth approx. 1100 feet offshore, a filled causeway or trestle, a parking area, and a terminal building. This project contributes to the Department's Mission by reducing injuries, fatalities and property damage, by improving the mobility of people and goods and by increasing private investment.
