Project Description/Justification:

The runway, apron and taxiway do not meet state standards for a community class airport. The embankment on the south end of the current runway is failing. Erosion has severely narrowed the current runway and created sharp drop-offs on both sides. The current runway is subject to severe cross winds and turbulence. This project changes runway orientation to alleviate the problem. Airport lighting will improve operations and safety during hours of limited visibility and darkness.
