Project Description/Justification:

Maintenance & Operations has requested a new maintenance equipment building closer to the airport. The Nome Master Plan update, completed in 1996, recommended that both the SREB and ARFF be constructed in the short term of the implementation schedule. The existing building has one bay, in which the trucks must park in tandem. In the event of a problem with the first vehicle, the second vehicle cannot exit the building. The Flight Service Station has requested that they combine their facility with the ARFF building, very similar to the design for Kotzebue.
