This grant program contributes to the Department's mission of promoting a healthy economy and strong communities by assisting communities in achieving maximum self-government.

**Project Description/Justification:**

To defray the cost of transition to city or borough government and to provide for interim government operations, each city incorporated, or each borough or unified municipality incorporated after December 31, 1985 is entitled to an organization grant under Alaska Statute 29.050.180 - .200.

Each city or second class city incorporated after December 31, 1985 is entitled to an organization grant as follows:

- (1) \$50,000 for the first full or partial fiscal year after incorporation; and
- (2) \$25,000 for the second fiscal year after incorporation.

Each borough or unified municipality incorporated after December 31, 1985, is entitled to organization grants as follows:

- (1) \$300,000 for the municipality's first full or partial fiscal year;
- (2) \$200,000 for the municipality's second fiscal year; and
- (3) \$100,000 for the municipality's third fiscal year.

Each third class borough that merges or consolidates with a city, and each municipality that unifies, in an area formerly occupied by a third class borough is entitled to an organization grant of \$200,000 for the municipality's first full or partial fiscal year after the merger or consolidation or after unification.

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For FY 2006, it is anticipated that the Prince William Sound Borough, City of Delta Junction, City of Anchor Point, and the City of Naukati will be eligible for this grant program.

This capital request is for the first year requirement only, subsequent appropriation requests will be necessary.
