South Rolly Lake Campground and Nancy Lake SRS Campground are located in the 22,685 acre Nancy Lake State Recreation Area at the end of Nancy Lake Parkway, 6.5 miles from the MP 67.3 of the Parks Highway. South Rolly Lake Campground was constructed in the late 1970's and the Nancy Lake SRS campground was built in the late 1960's. Most facilities within these campgrounds have exceeded their life cycle. This project would refurbish the campsites, upgrade the campground roads, parking areas, and replace the toilets and water wells.

Project Description/Justification:**Detailed Project Justification:**

Alaska Statute 41.21.020 states that one of the duties of the Department of Natural Resources is to maintain state parks and recreation areas for the general health, welfare, education, and enjoyment of Alaskans and visitors to the state. While Parks is able to do minor repairs and painting to annually maintain Park facilities, these facilities have been steadily declining. Rehabilitation of campgrounds require specific funding through the capital process. Construction contracts for repairs will provide private sector jobs. Many repairs, such as to cabins, volunteer housing, and picnic shelters can and will be done with volunteer labor.

Nancy Lake State Recreation area: is one of the few lake-studded landscapes in Alaska preserved in its natural state for recreation. It's ideal for canoeing, fishing and boating on a network of more than 130 lakes and ponds. This year-round facility provides recreational opportunities such as camping, hiking and skiing trails, twelve public rental cabins. The area is well used in winter by dog mushers, skiers and snowmachiners. It has long been considered one of the jewels of the State Park System.

Why is this Project Needed Now:

These facilities are older, requiring higher levels of annual maintenance and repair. This particular State Recreation Area has not received funding for maintenance and rehabilitation for several years. This has resulted in items that were of a

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lower priority in 2001 becoming a high priority due to the disrepair and high use of this popular recreational site within easy commute of Anchorage.

Specific Spending Detail:

This project will begin to address the specific maintenance and repair needs of Nancy Lake State Recreation Area:

Repairs will be accomplished by force account using State Park maintenance staff and procured materials, and by construction contracting. Force account work is typically 50 percent labor and 50 percent materials. Construction contracting is typical 20 percent design, procurement, and contract administration and 80 percent contractual cost.
