**Project Description/Justification:**

The main cross members of the deck are rotten and the decking needs to be replaced. The bridge is not level and the abutments, retained by logs, have a short design life due to the fact that this is not a dry wash and the continuous exposure to water has caused deterioration. The bridge is below design flood elevation and is recommended for replacement in the bridge deficiency report.
