Project Description/Justification:

The department manages a large fleet of snow removal equipment at the eleven airports in Southeast Region. Several pieces of equipment are replaced each year as they reach the end of their useful lives, become obsolete, or fail to meet the station's needs. In other cases, additional equipment is acquired because airport expansion or operational changes increase the workload beyond the capacity of the existing equipment at a station. Equipment acquired with federal Airport Improvement Program funds typically includes plow trucks with sanding and de-icing chemical spreaders, graders, snow blowers, and runway brooms.
