**Project Description/Justification:**

Selawik's boardwalks are the transportation routes over the marshy tundra for pedestrians, snowmachines, and all terrain vehicle (ATV) traffic. The existing boardwalks are narrow and have deteriorated to the point that maintenance is fiscally impractical and physically ineffective. Major sections of the system have rotted away and existing boardwalks are too narrow to accommodate two-way traffic or modern ATVs.
