**Project Description/Justification:**

Stage I of this project constructed a new frozen runway embankment with standard safety areas, an aircraft parking apron, taxiway and airport access road. The sand/silt embankment constructed during Stage I (completed in 2002) has consolidated and is ready for completion. This project will cap the embankment with aggregate and gravel surfacing material. Gravel is available on the adjacent Yukon River.
