Project Description/Justification:

The new access road will connect the community with the new landfill site.

The existing solid waste facility is unlined and unfenced and all types of wastes are disposed of at the site, including honey bucket and hazardous wastes (batteries, oil, and antifreeze). The solid waste site also reportedly drains directly into the creek that supplies community drinking water. The new landfill has been permitted and is being funded by the United States Department of Agriculture.
