FY2005 - \$1,260,000.

Project Description/Justification:

The airport needs an additional heated sand storage building to accommodate 500-1,000 cubic yards of stockpiled sand that is currently stored outside and is used for treatment of icy runways. The outside storage requires maintenance personnel to add urea to the sand to keep it from freezing solid. Eliminating the need to use urea will save up to \$75,000 per year in operating expenses.
