Project Description/Justification:

The Anvik runway is not long enough to accommodate the larger aircraft currently used by commercial carriers in the area. Additionally, the runway length, safety area dimensions, apron size and setback dimensions are all below State and FAA standards. The dust palliative will reduce loss of surfacing materials and improve air quality in the community.
