Project Description/Justification:

Road dust in the community is a health and safety issue. This contributes to chronic respiratory problems such as bronchitis, asthma, and a high incidence of sinus infection among the community members. People traditionally hang their subsistence meat and fish out to dry and cure in the summertime and the food gets gritty and covered with dirt.
