Project Description/Justification:

Dust is a health issue in Galena and is considered a high priority with the City and Tribal governments. The old town area is located on a narrow strip of land south of the dike and dust from the dike road permeates the entire area. Paving this road would minimize this health hazard. The roads within the new townsite have similar dust issues. The City is in the process of constructing piped water lines in the area, which will require some road reconstruction. It would be advantageous to combine the road modifications to add dust palliatives, thus saving money, and providing long term dust control solutions.
