Additional Information / Prior Funding History:

FY2003 GO Bonds - \$13,225,000. Per the department's new cost sharing policy, the community must provide half of the match for these funds.

Project Description/Justification:

Project is high maintenance priority due to poor pavement condition and will reduce maintenance costs. Shoulder width is substandard, with turning lanes needed for high turning movements at many locations. Several community schools and the high residential density along portions of the road call for a separated pedestrain facility for safety.
