Project Description/Justification:

The Yukon Flats School District operated a school at Mile 49.5 on the Elliott Highway (Joy) known as the Northern Lights School beginning in 1981. From 1991 until 1993 the school was closed and then reopened from 1994 through 1999 (7 students reported in 1999). The district excessed the buildings to the Department of Education & Early Development (EED) in 2000. EED began disposal procedures according to 4 AAC 31.085 in 2003. This process resulted in approximately 30% of the school buildings being removed in 2004 and 2005. This project will demolish the remaining portions.
