Project Description/Justification:

Project is needed to provide more reliable connection between the airport and the boat harbor. The current road is in a very deteriorated condition with many potholes, especially in the sections immediately adjacent to the bridge. Very little surface material remains on the road surface. Continued erosion has caused the existing bridge gabions to fail and the current bridge's rail transition does not meet standards. Improvements to this road will facilitate the movement of fresh seafood product from the new harbor to the airport.
