**Project Description/Justification:**

The Yukon Crossing serves as the intermodal transition point for highway and river traffic. The facility serves commercial, industrial, and recreational uses, as well as community access. This is one of only three boat launching sites on the road system to the Yukon River and is easily the one that receives the most use (in excess of 1,500 launches and retrieves per season). Currently the users of the landing site crowd into existing space and spill over into underdeveloped land and onto adjacent private land.
