Project Description/Justification:

Title is held for most of the remote airports in Central Region. However, situations arise wherein the Department of Transportation has an obligation to maintain and operate airports where the title is insufficient to qualify for Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) funding. Air navigations sites and Interim Agreements are examples of such situations. Federal laws require that a federally assisted airport project cannot be approved until the sponsor holds acceptable title to the airport lands, or gives satisfactory assurance that acceptable title will be acquired prior to construction. Central Region has identified eight airports where it is necessary to acquire good and sufficient title interests for present and future airport development.
