Project Description/Justification:

During a routine inspection, the lower mooring ramp in Pelican was determined to be unsafe and was condemned by Department of Transportation and Public Facilities engineers. The concrete cores supporting the lower ramp were broken through and could no longer support the weight of vehicles getting on or off the ferries. Emergency repairs were made by adding new timber matting, new metal and a transition plate. These repairs were necessary to prevent injury and ensure safe and continued operations. These emergency repairs totaled \$60,000.
