Repair damage caused by heavy rains during July of 2005 when the One Mile Creek, Darling Creek, Ruby Creek, and Whister Creek overflowed their banks along the Richardson Highway in the Trims area. Repairs include re-establishing channels by removing gravel and debris, rebuilding 700 linear feet of dikes, and placing rip-rap around bridge abutments.
