Several sections of the Brenwick - Craig Road fell into the Klutina River near Copper Center due to major landslides during August of 2005. Six areas along the Brenwick - Craig Road require realignment, totaling two miles of repair area. Clearing and grubbing with an excavator will get underway while the ground is still frozen. Material will be hauled from an AHTNA, Inc. source and new roadbed construction will commence this spring. The Brenwick - Craig Road is a state-owned facility that provides access from the Richardson Highway to the Klutina River and Klutina Lake for sport and subsistence fishing as well as access to state, federal, and privately owned land.
