This is a new FY07 Capital Budget Request. Construct a new 700-foot long road to the solid waste drying beds. Project will also include raising the road grade on the existing landfill road for approximately 900 feet across Kouwegok Slough Bridge and installing delineators every 200 feet along the 2.8 mile length landfill road. This project contributes to the Department's Mission by reducing injuries, fatalities and property damage and by improving the mobility of people and goods.

Additional Information / Prior Funding History:

FY2006 - \$350,000; FY2005 - \$150,000.

Project Description/Justification:

The existing sewage lagoon is being overhauled and expanded to accommodate the growing population in Unalakleet. Sludge drying beds are being constructed at the existing landfill and access is needed to the beds. The landfill road is also being raised to mitigate flooding that prevents access to the sanitary landfill. Delineators will increase safety of the traveling public, during high winds and drifting snow.
