Project Description/Justification:

Engstrom Road is a two-lane paved facility off of Bogard Road in the Mat-Su Borough approximately 0.5 mile west of the Bogard/Trunk Road intersection. The project would provide for a 0.5-mile long grade raise of the road base near Cornelius Lake to alleviate snow-drifting problems. In addition to repaving the raised base, improvements may require limited Right-of-Way (ROW) acquisition and drainage work. Snow drifting is currently a serious problem with traffic having to be rerouted through small subdivision roads. This project will improve safety, and the Matanuska-Susitna Borough will be taking over ownership and maintenance of all improvements.
