**Project Description/Justification:**

Akiachak is a community of 509 persons. No homes are plumbed. The village provides a honey bucket haul service. The existing road system in Akiachak is in poor condition. The roads are constructed of sand and would not hold up to the heavy use that will come from a truck haul sanitation system. Public Health Service is constructing a new sewage lagoon and water access point. The current roads will be inadequate to provide for public access to these facilities.
