Construct road, utility and ground improvements at various airside and landside locations. This project will include work such as repairs/upgrades to public roads and the tug road system, repairs/upgrades to sewer systems, airport mapping and surveying, constructing utilities to new development sites, constructing grounds, parking, trails, signage, lighting, traffic signals, drainage, landscaping, and utilities improvements, acquisition of easements, rights-of-ways and land interests. This project contributes to the Department's Mission by reducing injuries, fatalities and property damage and by improving the mobility of people and goods.

Project Description/Justification:

These improvements include, but are not limited to, rehabilitation and construction of tugroads. It includes, but is not limited to stormdrain inlet improvements around the terminals, on Runway 7R, in West Airpark, East Airpark and North Airpark. The project will realign Aircraft Drive to the north of general aviation Parking Area E. Approximately 2,000 feet of new road will be constructed and an additional 2,500 feet will be paved. The project eliminates the existing taxiway/road intersection. The project includes, but is not limited to, repairing, repaving and reconstructing various roads within the airport. This will include drainage improvements, utility adjustment/relocation, lighting, and sidewalks will be constructed as needed. The amount of construction required for each road will vary based on the condition of the road and the anticipated amount of traffic. Roads in good condition will be patched and any existing cracks sealed to extend the life. Roads in poor condition will be reconstructed.
