Dear Fred,

It is the intention of the City of Petersburg to expend the \$25,000 grant for the community shooting range by performing the following:

1. Replace one of two Trap Machines, w/activator.
2. Replace trap shooting stations on both courses.
3. Replace both trap shooting scoring platforms.
4. Rehab and replace the pistol range access.
5. Rehab and replace crushed rock pad on the rifle range to the 200 yard station.
6. Improve roadway with crushed rock and install a cross culvert to improve drainage.
