Project Description:

The Alaska Native Brotherhood Camp 13 in Yakutat is a long-standing organization of great importance to the community. Since its construction, more than 80 years ago, the ANB Hall has become the most popular gathering place in Yakutat. However, the years have taken their toll on the hall and immediate repairs are needed before a more thorough renovation can begin. The east and south walls of the facility have been severely decayed due to wind-driven rain. Decay destroys the strength of the wooden studs to resist wind and gravity loads. Repairing the walls now will prevent further decay and will restabilize the entire building. The money requested will go towards replacing the decayed east and south walls of the Yakutat ANB Hall, which will restabilize the building.
