Detailed Project Description and Justification:

The Ralph Perdue Center (RPC) is the only facility in the Interior that provides medically monitored detoxification services and substance abuse treatment. With the recent loss of residential beds in the community it is more important than ever this limited facility be maintained.

FNA is receiving a discount from their contractor on this project which they can only take advantage of if Phase Two is implemented as a single upgrade. The RPC is currently in Phase Two of a major building renovation and is looking to the Legislature for \$125,861 in additional funding.
