Completing the design phase will assist the Valdez City Schools and the City of Valdez in obtaining the necessary funding to accomplish this project. Valdez City Schools is presently under and <u>Order to Correct</u> this system by the City's Fire Marshall.	\$18,000

5	5	<p><b><u>Valdez High School Gymnasium Lighting and Controls Upgrade – Design:</u></b> these funds will be used to select and contract with a design firm to design the necessary repairs and renovations of the Valdez High School Gymnasium lighting system. The selected firm will deliver construction documents, permits and cost estimates of the project. Completing the design phase will assist the Valdez City Schools and the City of Valdez in obtaining the necessary funding to accomplish this project. Valdez has one of the highest costs of electricity of any municipality in the state. This facility is in constant use for both school and community activities.</p>	\$6,000
6	6	<p><b><u>Hermon Hutchens Elementary School Gymnasium Lighting and Controls Upgrade – Design:</u></b> these funds will be used to select and contract with a design firm to design the necessary repairs and renovations of the Hermon Hutchens Elementary School Gymnasium lighting system. The selected firm will deliver construction documents, permits and cost estimates of the project. Completing the design phase will assist the Valdez City Schools and the City of Valdez in obtaining the necessary funding to accomplish this project. Valdez has one of the highest costs of electricity of any municipality in the state. This facility is in constant use for both school and community activities.</p>	\$6,000

<b>Project</b>	<b>Priority</b>	<b>Description</b>	<b>Amount</b>
7	7	<b>George Gilson Jr. High Modular Roof Replacement:</b> these funds will be used to purchase and install insulation and roofing materials on the modular portion of the Jr. High School. This metal roof has exceeded its useful life and has failed.	\$28,000
8	8	<b>Valdez High School Gymnasium Wrestling Mat Hangers:</b> these funds will be used to design, purchase and install wrestling mat hangers in the ceiling of the Valdez High School Gymnasium. These hangers will help relieve the shortage of storage for school and community athletic and activity equipment.	\$12,000
9	9	<b>Valdez High School Library Solarium Window Replacement:</b> these funds will be used to purchase and replace the solarium window structure in the Valdez High School Library. This structure has totally failed; it leaks and represents a huge energy loss. The thermo pane glass panel seals have all failed and replacement is our only option.	\$22,000
10	10	<b>Athletic Field Design and Improvement:</b> these funds will be used to select and contract with a design firm to design the necessary repairs and renovations of the Valdez City School District Athletic Fields. The present field's surface is loose sand and gravel and has poor drainage. Its condition represents a hazard to the students and athletes that use it.	\$10,000


