Detailed Project Description and Justification:

The upgrade of 88th ave is a road transfer project (RTP) with ownership and the responsibility for maintenance transferring to the Municipality of Anchorage at the start of construction. As a RTP, the project will reduce future state responsibilities for the road.

Currently, 88th ave does not meet current standards for pavement, curbs, drainage, pedestrian facilities and lighting. The pavement is currently deteriorating and the upgrade will result in a safer road for drivers and residents of the area.
