Detailed Project Description and Justification:

The City of Anderson is in the final phases of construction of a new sewage lagoon located approximately ten miles from the city center. A piece of equipment needs to be dedicated to this lagoon because of the unsanitary conditions that this equipment will be working in. The skid steer loader with attachments will be used to remove the dried sludge from the receiving cells. This equipment is designed for this system and will not damage the liners as would a large 966 loader. Due to health and safety issues, this equipment would be dedicated to the lagoon.
