**Project Description/Justification:**

\$75 million will be allocated to communities under a population-based formula similar to that used in FY08. Of this, 95% will be allocated to borough and city governments with each borough receiving a base allocation of \$250,000 and each city receiving a base allocation of \$75,000. The remaining 5% will be allocated for eligible unincorporated communities located in the unorganized borough, with each receiving a base allocation of \$25,000 plus a per capita distribution up to \$75,000.
