**Project Description/Justification:**

The Department of Corrections (DOC) is responsible for maintaining 117 state-owned buildings (over 1.3 million square feet and approximately \$463.2 million in replacement value). A majority of these buildings are over 20 years old; 10% exceed 30 years of age and 10% exceed 40 years of age.

The repair/replacement requirements are necessary to ensure that the facilities will continue to operate safely. Following a national standard adopted by all Alaska state agencies for estimating annual renewal and replacement requirements (ANNUAL RENEWAL REQUIREMENTS = 75% X Current Replacement Value X Age of Building / 1275), the Department needs approximately \$3.7 million in annual funding to properly maintain the facilities. This budget request will address the most essential work that must be accomplished this fiscal year.

Maintenance, renovation, repair and replacements are required on a continual basis in order to maintain efficient, secure and safe correctional facilities. These facilities are operated on a 24/7 hour basis which continually supports the life, health and safety needs of approximately 3,700 inmates per day. The sustained use of these facilities requires annual maintenance and repairs to meet security/life/safety of the prisoners and staff.

The Department anticipates that roughly 20% of this funding will be used for emergency work that occurs annually throughout the agency.

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Funding appropriated from this request will be allocated towards the most essential elements of the following priority projects:
