2. What is the purpose of the project?

This project will provide for an interface between the Division of Vocational Rehabilitation's Management Information System, the Accessible Web-based Activity and Reporting Environment (AWARE) and the Alaska State Accounting System (AKSAS) thus eliminating the need to key in payment requests in both systems. The Division of Vocational Rehabilitation processes an average of 15,000 payment requests annually. We estimate approximately 50% of an Accounting Technician's time is spent keying in this information, eliminating this task will free staff up for other

necessary tasks. Also implementation of this project will afford the Division the opportunity to take advantage of the available technology as the State continues to move forward with P-cards and electronic payments.
