Brief Summary and Statement of Need:

This program links the motor carrier safety information system of the Department of Transportation and Public Facilities (DOT&PF) and similar State systems with State commercial motor vehicle registration and licensing systems to determine the safety fitness of the motor carrier prior to issuing license plates. This will also cause the carrier to improve its safety performance through an improvement process, and where necessary, apply sanctions. This project contributes to the Department's Mission by reducing injuries, fatalities and property damage and by improving the mobility of people and goods.

Project Description/Justification:

PRISM is a cooperative federal/state safety program designed to identify motor carriers with deficient safety records, and in so doing, tie a motor carrier's safety fitness to the ability to register their trucks. The project is to develop a database containing motor carrier safety information with input provided directly by the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration. The information within the database will then be directly accessible by the Division of Motor Vehicles and the Division of Measurement Standards and Commercial Vehicle Enforcement to review when issuing commercial vehicle registrations. The FY09 request is to cover recurring maintenance costs.
