Resurface the runway and taxiway and place a dust palliative on the surfaces at the Chalkyitsik Airport; relocate the apron and access road; replace the snow removal equipment building (SREB); rehabilitate the airport lighting system; correct drainage problems at the end of the runway and complete other improvements as funding allows. This project contributes to the Department's Mission by reducing injuries, fatalities and property damage and by improving the mobility of people and goods.

**Project Description/Justification:**

The runway gravel surface is thin; rutting is occurring in the spring and during rainy periods. Poor drainage has caused significant erosion at the end of the runway; the safety area has been damaged and needs restoration. The apron and the location of the snow removal equipment building (SREB) do not meet Federal Aviation Administration standards. Due to its condition, the SREB will be replaced in a new location.
