In FY09, Habitat received an additional \$30,000 for gaging work associated with the Pebble Mine and an additional \$25,000 associated with the Pogo Mine. This program allows Habitat to accept funds from the private sector to pass through to the U.S. Geological Survey (USGS). Funds passed to the federal agency can then be matched up to 100% by the federal government.

Project Description/Justification:

This program allows Habitat to accept funds from the private sector and local governments and to pass those funds through to the U.S. Geological Survey (USGS), as part of a funding agreement for cooperative water resource programs. Industry and local governments often request and pay for the USGS to install and operate equipment to obtain hydrologic data. These types of projects have been treated as CIP in the past and a similar project is in the FY10 CIP budget.
