**Project Description/Justification:**

Sidewalk improvements are necessary to comply with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA). Wendell Street is the location of the new Morris Thompson Cultural and Visitor's Center and tourists will be dropped off and picked up there by bus companies. Improving the pedestrian facilities and repaving will enhance this new cultural visitor destination in Fairbanks. The storm drains are 40-year-old wood stave pipes and are in dire need of replacement.
