Additional Information / Prior Funding History:**Project Description/Justification:**

Several sections of the Richardson Highway, totaling five miles between MP 10 and MP 80, were significantly damaged by the October 2006 extreme storm and flood event. Emergency repairs were completed shortly after the disaster to restore essential traffic. This project will make the permanent repairs that are necessary to restore the roadway to its pre-disaster condition, including repairs to several bridges.
