**Brief Summary and Statement of Need:**

This funding will make improvements and/or repairs that arise during the year that cannot be foreseen during the budget planning process. Projects typically result from winter snow/ice damage, facility and equipment failures, and changed operating rules/requirements. This project contributes to the Department's Mission by improving the mobility of people and goods and by reducing injuries, fatalities and property damage.

**Additional Information / Prior Funding History:**

FY2007 - \$1,050,000; FY2005 - \$300,000; FY2004 - \$300,000; FY2002 - \$700,000.

**Project Description/Justification:**

This funding consistently solves what would otherwise be unworkable problems for the airfield, landside and terminal areas, thereby ensuring continued airport operations.

Projects have included:

- Advanced/emergency/bulk purchase of urea (used for snow removal) due to news of pending Agrium closure
- Delta Taxiway improvements (drainage) due to snow/ice damage resulting from freeze/thaw
- Various unanticipated equipment repairs not included in equipment budget, i.e., engine rebuild due to blow up (past warranty but pre-replacement), replacement of mold board due to damage (manhole raise due to permafrost heave/covered with snow), etc.
- Security improvements, i.e., door locks, cameras, resulting from increased TSA (Transportation Security Administration)secure-area regulatory enforcement
- Rehabilitation of float pond ramp due to permafrost heaving damage
- Float pond tank study in response to federal inspection of area
