## **Department of Administration Enterprise Technology Services Component Budget Summary**

**Component: Enterprise Technology Services**

## Contribution to Department's Mission

Provide a robust and secure information technology infrastructure together with enterprise services that support state agencies' business needs.

## Core Services

- Secure and assure the integrity of State Information
- Administration, management and maintenance of State Information Technology enterprise infrastructure (including the Wide Area Network/WAN), and facilities
- Administration, management and support for enterprise applications (Directory Services, Email & Calendaring, Interactive Voice Response, SOA Website, Web Services including credit card processing, myAlaska, electronic signature, and Electronic Funds Transfer)
- Project Management
- Customer Services: Service Desk ; Database Administration; Data Center Operations including printing services; Server Hosting
- Telecommunication Services: Paging, Telephony (VoIP, Cellular, Satellite, Mobile Device, Video-conferencing)
- Backup, disaster recovery of IT systems and data

## Results at a Glance

### END RESULT A: Reliable communications and networks.

- The percent up-time for the state's mainframe computer system has remained constant at 99.8% over the past three years.
- In FY2009 an aggregate 5% of ETS system technologies were significantly upgraded.

#### Status of Strategies to Achieve End Result

- In FY2008, 86% of scheduled maintenance and upgrades on core system technologies were completed. In FY2009, 82% were completed.

### END RESULT B: State agencies gain confidence in ETS.

- In order to measure customer confidence and satisfaction in Enterprise Technology Services, a service level agreement template has been completed. Negotiations with customer agencies are currently underway. Service level measurement data will be available by March 31, 2010.
- In FY2007 71% of Priority 1 service requests were closed within four hours. In FY2008 76% were closed within four hours. In FY2009 80% were closed within four hours

#### Status of Strategies to Achieve End Result

- To identify areas of customer concern ETS will design and administer an online customer concern survey with results available by June 30, 2010.

## Key Component Challenges

The business needs of State agencies have always been and will continue to be the primary focus of ETS' core services, priorities and staffing.

The most significant IT issues in support of agencies' mission-critical programs and services are:

- Successful deployment of security initiatives
- Network improvements and bandwidth upgrades (where possible) to enhance services across the State WAN
- Enterprise planning for data centers, application development & support, and staffing
- Recruitment & retention of qualified staff

ETS continues to carefully manage the public-private partnerships that provide IT infrastructure and support that is cost effective yet able to quickly respond to changing technologies and market conditions. One such partnership has resulted in the execution of a beneficial core services contract to provide management and technical assistance with telephony, network monitoring and management, as well as video and audio conferencing.

Commitment to a centralized “enterprise” for core services continues to drive projects for ETS. Successful completion of projects such as Voice Over Internet Protocol (VoIP) telephony and the Exchange calendaring/email are examples. Both projects have expanded the state’s infrastructure. This, in turn, makes it possible to leverage these new technologies by adding enterprise tools that significantly enhance state employees’ efforts in more efficiently carrying out their responsibilities. In FY2011, ETS will complete its plans for relocation of the Anchorage Data Center. In addition, ETS will deploy WAN accelerators in key hub communities of the state.

## **Significant Changes in Results to be Delivered in FY2011**

The ETS Virtual Manager application, its time-keeping, asset-based application, will continue to support real-time reporting on project costs and resource allocations. This application will continue to be refined through FY2011 to provide more robust reporting on all resource allocations to further enhance its use as a real-time management tool. In addition, a full Asset Management System, developed in FY2010, will be expanded to include up-to-date data on all ETS assets, including hardware, circuits, and software licenses. Bandwidth capacity will be increased. Upgrades are planned that will enhance network environmentals, security services, and digital telephony.

## **Major Component Accomplishments in 2009**

ETS designed and implemented a 24 X 7 Mt. Redoubt Ash Fall Response Plan to monitor and respond to volcanic eruptions as necessary. The plan was supported by two (2) teams of responders, one of which was continuously on call for the several months that Mt. Redoubt was active. The plan was in service until the threat was reduced to minimal and activity declined significantly, at which time the teams stood down.

### Administrative Services

1. Improved business process for ETS Travel Procedures
2. Developed an improved business Process for ETS Training Request
3. Coordinated the “lock down” of the Tudor Road facility to meet security requirements with minimal impact to staff, contractors, and other public agencies/visitors
4. Added a “Get Smarter” component to ETS all-staff meetings to increase knowledge base for all staff, in a variety of areas.
5. Administrative staff worked diligently to clear 313 outstanding transactions in two weeks, equal to 90% of uncleared transactions. Clearing AutoPay has been an issue for ETS. This is an excellent first for ETS.
6. Coordinated with procurement staff to solidify approval procedures.
7. Administrative Services has enjoyed success in getting managers current on performance evaluations for their direct reports.

### Database Administration

1. Upgraded DB2 on the Mainframe to version 8, compatibility mode.
2. Upgraded EntireX Broker middleware to version 7.3.3.
3. Upgraded Predict data dictionary to 4.5.2.
4. Upgraded all Natural programming environment regions to version 4.2.3.
5. Anticipate completing Adabas 8 upgrade during FY10.

### Enterprise Applications & Server Hosting

1. Increased security of Tivoli Storage Management (TSM) back-up system by implementing fully encrypted offsite tapes.
2. Created Fiber Channel Storage Area Network allowing the flexible accessing and sharing of storage resources among servers.

3. Acquired IBM Bladecenter solution saving 40% in space, power and cooling over previous platforms.
4. Installed and configured first rack of IBM Bladecenter gear for server hosting.
5. Selected and initiated deployment of Symantec Enterprise Vault using IBM Bladecenter solution with fully redundant Storage Area Network infrastructure.
6. Completed the Requirements gathering for myAlaska and Workplace Alaska next releases.
7. Provided Exchange e-mail and calendaring services with better than 99.6% uptime each month since August 2008, with the exception of three incidents where e-mail was queued up between sites due to network transmission problems.
8. Continue Education Opportunities for Staff
  - a. Writing Secure Code - Application Security
  - b. VMWare administration
  - c. Windows Server 2008 Directory Services Workshop
  - d. SQL Server 2005 Failover Clustering

#### Mainframe Services

1. Completed z/OS (Mainframe operating system) 1.9 upgrade and all associated 3<sup>rd</sup> party products on December 2008, culmination of year-long project.
2. Successfully performed disaster recovery testing, with some customer involvement on Aug. 09 -12, 2009.
3. Connect: Direct replacement project by Social Security Administration, resulting in reduced software charges in Mainframe rates.
4. Completed year of Sub-Capacity reporting and billing, saving software monthly maintenance costs.
5. Implemented TN3270 secure communication for all customers.
6. Completed migration of remaining regions to DB2 V8 in compatibility mode.
7. Completed migration of DB2 V8 regions to "new function mode" for all regions except Department of Labor production which will occur in September 2009.
8. Prepared for DB2 V 9 installation and customization.
9. Install CICS 4.1 into production, and CICS CSM.
10. 3<sup>rd</sup> party software contract renewals.

#### Network Services

1. Network preparation is 95% complete to support AD project in the rural locations.
2. Completed Tudor campus fiber ring, upgrading speed and connectivity for Anchorage.
3. Completed Phase III of Telephone Replacement Project including decommissioning the PBX equipment in Juneau and Anchorage without unplanned downtime.
4. Increased internet bandwidth by 25%.
5. Implemented 45 megabit (DS3), carrier-grade, microwave upgrade, from Anchorage across the Kenai Peninsula WAN link, resulting in 27 times greater capacity.
6. Completed 43 Mat-Su (including Eagle River) metro-ethernet conversions with an average bandwidth upgrade of 2 Megabits. This effectively has tripled bandwidth in this area.
7. Completed 13 Ketchikan metro-ethernet conversions with an average bandwidth upgrade of 2 Megabits, resulting in tripling the bandwidth; while, at the same time, have doubled long-haul bandwidth into Ketchikan.
8. Completed 10 Tok metro-ethernet conversions with an average bandwidth upgrade of 2 Megabits or tripling the bandwidth at no net cost change.
9. Completed 14 Kodiak metro-ethernet conversions with an average bandwidth upgrade of 5 Megabits, effectively doubling capacity.
10. Installed new city connections on Kuskokwim delta microwave system: Emmonak, St. Marys, Aniak.

#### Project Management & Planning

1. Successfully designed and executed Mt. Redoubt Ash Fall Response Plan.
2. Project Management training courses are underway.

#### Security

1. Research and Development for the Zantaz (email archive and legal discovery) Replacement.
2. Successfully managed and mitigated the increased threats that occurred during the election process.

3. Performed hundreds of data collections for Public Records Requests, Legal Discoveries and Employee Investigations.
4. Acquired, installed and implemented Sourcefire Intrusion Prevention System.
5. Completed Service MOU with DPS.

Service Centers

1. Initiated the design of a new Anchorage facility to replace Anchorage Data Center.
2. Brought the current Anchorage Data Center into compliance with Anchorage fire code.
3. Initiated project to replace 25+ year old air conditioners in the Juneau Data Center. This equipment will be more energy efficient and quieter than current technology. Projected completion is January of 2010.
4. Initiated new overhead cable management system in the Juneau Data Center.
5. Completed phase I of the power re-grooming project at the Anchorage Data Center.
6. Initiated the move of State of Alaska's Network Operations Center (NOC) located in the Juneau central area office core.
7. Moved the Anchorage Data Center's generator backup functions from generator #2 to generator #1, resulting in more efficient operations together with more reliable backup capability.
8. Implemented new physical security policies for the Anchorage and Juneau Data Centers.

Pursuant to Section 1, Chapter 12, SLA 2009, page 4 - lines 6-12, \$97,200 is distributed to state agencies in order to pay service costs charged by the Department of Administration, Enterprise Technology Services for centralized personnel services.

The amounts transferred to state agencies from ETS are as follows:  
DCED, \$8.0; Revenue, \$23.9; Law, \$3.6; Labor, \$26.4; DNR, \$2.9; H&SS, \$17.2; Administration, \$15.2.
