Brief Project Description:

This project will construct phase II safety and maintenance upgrades on three well used hillside transportation routes.

Funding Plan:**Total Cost of Project: \$2,500,000***There is no other funding needed***Detailed Project Description and Justification:**

Specific improvements are expected to include right-of-way acquisition, a new road base, pavement and improved culverts and drainage. All three roads are in need of upgrades. Improvements are a priority for the Glen Alps Community Council and provide access to Chugach State Park. There is significant year-round usage, especially at the Flat Top Trailhead. The existing roads are mostly poor gravel roads with steep slopes, winding curves and limited visibility. There are no pedestrian facilities or even shoulders to accommodate hikers and cyclists. A design study and phase I design and construction have been funded with a state grant.

This grant will fund phase II design, easement, and construction efforts. Additional phases may be identified for future funding.

Project Timeline:

Design, easement and utility expenditures are anticipated in 2010 and 2011. Construction spending is anticipated in 2011 and 2012.
